## CybageKhushboo distributes scholarships for higher education of underprivileged

The event began with Mrs. Ritu Nathani, Managing Trustee, CybageKhushboo, informing the beneficiaries about the rules pertaining to the scholarships. She spoke about CybageKhushboo's belief in education being the tool that can provide a level playing field for the underprivileged and bridge the disparities in our country.

In the first batch, a total 9 students of Karve Institute of Social Service received scholarships

with volunteers giving away cheques worth a total ₹ 1,43,240. Prof. Mahesh Thakur thanked CybageKhushboo for associating with their college and helping the needy students. CybageKhushboo is collaborating with this institute for the first time. All the students who received the scholarship are pursuing Masters in Social Work (MSW).

In the second batch, 15 students of Vishwakarma Institute of Technology (VIT) and Vishwakarma Institute of Information Technology (VIIT) received scholarships worth a total ₹ 7,35,000. During the event Prof. Nitin Patki, Dean-Planning and Development (VIT), was present.

In the third batch, scholarships amounting to a total ₹ 2,45,115 were distributed to 9 students of MUCC. Dr. Vijayalakshmi Nambiar, Principal, MUCC, thanked CybageKhushboo for associating with the college for the last seven years and helping needy students.
