CybageKhushboo Students Attend Interview Skills and Group Discussion Session



Communication is the key, and owing to that, CybageKhushboo planned an entire series based on interview skills—for the third and final year students—to become more expressive in English language. The purpose of this session was to make the students undergo impromptu mock interviews and teach them how to actively participate and clear the group discussion in interviews.

The sessions were spanned across three days, 5th, 12th, and 19th November 2017, for six hours each day. Pankaj Mittal, CybageKhushboo trainer, prepared its beneficiaries for face-to-face interviews in a series of three sessions.



Pankaj stressed on the importance of being confident in today's age of competition. Even though all beneficiaries are extremely gifted, job interviews test not only the knowledge of a student but also the student's ability to use it at the right time.



In the first two sessions, Pankaj explained to the students, the importance of communication. This included understanding how punctuality, attire, and body language can affect the outcome of an interview. The next two sessions helped students learn how to prepare for an interview and answer more effectively.

Pankaj advised that before appearing for an interview, students must research about the organization and the position they are applying for. He further added that the ideal way to answer interview questions is to 'listen'.

The students performed well in the mock interviews conducted by Pankaj. The series was attended by 30 students, which was focused on boosting the confidence of the students and helping them attempt an interview successfully.
